

DON'T FORGET

- Students who come on an F-1 visa are allowed to enter the U.S. up to 30 days before the start date listed on their I20.
- F-1 students should allow enough time to enroll in their course, provide the necessary documents, have their visa appointment, and arrive in the U.S. Students should select a start date no sooner than at least4 months from the time they enroll.
- Students should plan their Live Lectures towards the middle/second half of their program for best outcomes.

THE PERFECT ROTATION

We aim to provide the international medical community with access to high-quality medical education in the United States. To be eligible, you must be a current medical, nursing, or dentistry student. We also accept recent graduates and professionals. Proof of eligibility is required in the form of a letter of good standing from your school or an applicable degree.

DETERMINING CREDENTIALING

Your institution must determine if AMO's clinical experiences can be used for credit. AMO will work with your school to see if it is possible to meet school requirements. If you intend to use our clinical experiences for credit, please confirm they meet your school requirement before reserving, as AMO does not offer refunds for cancellations.

HANDS-ON CLINICAL EXPERIENCES VS. OBSERVERSHIPS

AMO offers both hands-on clinical experiences and observerships. Hands-on clinical experiences involve patient-focused clinical exposure. Visitors have basic interactions with patients, which may include recording medical histories and performing physical examinations. Hands-on does not mean the visitor is allowed to function as a licensed physician.

Observerships do not include patient contact. Visitors gain exposure to the U.S. medical system as they observe their supervising physician. Visitors may participate in case presentations or help make differential diagnoses if the supervising physician allows it.

Regardless of the type of clinical experience a visitor takes part in, he or she must adhere to all HIPAA and Joint Commission regulations and state regulatory guidelines. It is the responsibility of each visitor to be responsible for their actions. At no time should a visitor engage in the unsupervised practice of medicine or represent him or herself as a licensed professional. Doing so is considered a felony criminal offense.

INPATIENT AND OUTPATIENT

Programs are listed as either inpatient, outpatient, or inpatient/outpatient, which is a combination of the two. The inpatient clinical experiences occur in a hospital setting where visitors follow the supervising physician as they complete their rounds. Outpatient clinical experiences take place in a clinic or at the physician's private practice. An Inpatient/Outpatient experience will consist of both clinic and hospital exposure. In this type of rotation, you gain training in both settings based on patient load. Many clinical experiences are a combination of inpatient and outpatient per U.S. medicine requirements in certain medical specialties

VIRTUAL CLINICAL EXPERIENCES

In addition to our in-person observership and hands-on clinical experiences, AMO offers virtual clinical experiences. These programs allow participants to learn about the U.S. healthcare system and earn an LoR from wherever they are in the world. Virtual clinical experiences are a great option for those looking to save on transportation/living expenses and avoid the hassle of securing a visa and the immunizations needed for inperson experiences.

Tele health is becoming increasingly commonplace in medicine as it is a safe and convenient method of providing care to patients. Gaining experience with tele health medicine early can help individuals stand out from their peers and gain new skills, which may include troubleshooting common technology issues and connecting with patients virtually.

PLANNING YOUR VISIT TO THE U.S.

BUDGETING FOR THE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

AMO rotations starts at \$999. This price is based on location, experience type, and the affiliated institution or hospital. The experience fee covers physician payment, coordinating services, and administrating fees. It does not cover:

Housing

- Travel
- Food
- Visa fees
- Insurance

A reservation deposit is collected up front to secure your clinical experience, while the remaining fees are due 45 days prior to your start date to complete enrollment.

SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

To attend a clinical experience, AMOpportunities requires you to submit:

- Resume or CV*
- Proof of eligibility*
- Passport*
- Immunizations
- Malpractice Insurance (program dependent)*
- Health Insurance Visa

*Only required documents for virtual clinical experiences/tele-rotations

We also require proof of English proficiency. If your medical school teaches in English, then a letter stating this from a dean or professor will suffice. Otherwise, you can submit the TOEFL, IELTS, or other equivalent. If neither of these are applicable to you, but you are proficient in English, you may schedule a short phone call with AMO to confirm your English proficiency.

OBTAIN A VISA

For those who do not already have a visa or who are not from a country where a waiver is applicable, we recommend applying for a B1 visa. You may join under another eligible U.S. visa, however, we only provide support for B1 visas. AMOpportunities provides placement letters upon acceptance and invitation letters upon reservation.

In the case that an individual is denied a visa, we can postpone the clinical experience and the individual can reapply with a letter directly from the hospital. For those who are not planning to try for a visa again, we will provide a half refund in the amount paid for the reservation. Historically, 90 percent of our students secure visas with their first application.

SECURE HOUSING

While it is the visitor's responsibility to secure housing, AMOpportunities can provide suggestions for companies to rent through based on the clinical site's location.

Your AMO Coach will provide you with information for our partner homestay companies American Homestay Network and Sara's Homestay. These companies work with you to secure housing with a kind and welcoming host located near your clinical experience site. Another option is Airbnb, which provides you with more flexibility. You can search with adjustable filters that account for certain preferences. Some renters provide guests with an extended stay discount.

We do our best to locate accommodations and third-party vendors to give the closest and most reasonable options. The trainee must reserve and pay for the housing themselves. As you search for your stay, you can always ask your AMO Coach for guidance.

OBTAIN HEALTH AND MALPRACTICE INSURANCE

Clinical experiences require U.S. health insurance that can be obtained easily through a vendor. AMO partners with Visitors Coverage to provide health insurance options.
